Conditions of Play - Women's Representative Fixture

Date - Saturday 9th December 2017

Report by 8:30am - Start Time – 9:00am

Special Conditions of Play

1. **Laws and Regulations:** Played under the **Laws of the Sport of Bowls** and Bowls New Zealand Associated Regulations as applicable.
2. **Controlling Body:** The Controlling Body for this tournament is one representative from Auckland, North Harbour and Northland Centre's. The Controlling Body will have the right to alter, add to or delete any conditions of play and/or special conditions to enable the completion of the tournament.
3. **Composition of Sides:** Each side shall comprise a singles player, one pair's team, one triples team and a fours team. Reserve players are permitted and all sides may be changed before each round.
4. **Trial Ends:** Pursuant to Law 5.1 of the Laws of the Sport trial ends will be allowed before competition commences for the day.
5. **Bowls: Singles** - 4 bowls, **21** shots; **Pairs** - 3 bowls , **18** ends; **Triples** – 2 bowls, **18** ends: and **Fours** - 2 bowls, **15** ends
6. **Advice by Manager or Coach:** Either the manager or the coach of the side can give advice to a player(s) in their side during the course of this competition in accordance with Law 44 of the Laws of the Sport of Bowls (Crystal Mark Third Edition).
7. **Substitutes:** Substitutes and changes to original team members will be allowed. Players may inter-change between the singles, pairs and fours disciplines and the order of play in pairs and fours may be changed before any game.
8. **Clothing:** Player's footwear must comply with the provisions of Bowls New Zealand Regulation 11.
9. **Jury of Appeal:** The Jury of Appeal will consist of a Member from each Auckland, North Harbour and Northland Centre's.
10. **Defaults:** If a team defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The non-offending team will be awarded a win and the average net total of shots scored by the winning teams in the same discipline in the same round of the same section.
11. **No Smoking Policy:** Smoking is banned anywhere in the club house and on the greens. Clubs have designated "smoking areas" which must be used by players and officials.
12. **Time Limit:** There will be a **two hour time limit** for these games.
13. **Restricting the movement of players during play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:
 - Singles:** After the delivery of their **third** and **fourth** bowl.
 - Pairs: Leads:** After the delivery of their **third** bowl.
 - Skips:** After the delivery of their **second** bowl.
 - Triples: Leads** after the **second player** in their team has delivered their **second** bowl.
 - Seconds:** after delivery of their **second** bowl.
 - Skips:** after delivery of **each** of their bowls.
 - Fours: Leads** after the **second player** in their team has delivered their **second** bowl.
 - Seconds:** after delivery of their **second** bowl.
 - Thirds:** after delivery of their **second** bowl and
 - Skips:** after delivery of **each** of their bowls.

In exceptional and limited circumstances, a player can ask the marker for permission to walk up to the head earlier than described above. If a player does not meet the terms of this law, Law 35 will apply.

14. **Variations to conditions of play:** The Controlling Body may vary the conditions of play by reducing the number of ends and/or limiting the time of any game, or reducing the number of games but any decisions must be made before the commencement of a game otherwise Law 55.3 of the Laws of the Sport of Bowls applies.
15. **Determining a winner:** In all games three points will be awarded for each game won and one point for each game drawn. Where game points are equal the winner will be the team with the highest net total of shots. If the game points and the net total of shots are equal the team with the lowest "total shots against" will be the winner. If the game points, net total of shots and shots against are all equal the winners will be decided on the result of the games played when the two sides met.
16. **Regional Trophy:** The results of both Men's & Women's will be added together to find a Winner of this event and then added to October Round's Scores to find the overall winner for each group 1-5 & 1-8.

Please Note – Northland have the Bye in Round One.
