<p>Border entry measures to minimise risk of importing COVID-19 cases.</p> <p>Intensive testing for COVID-19</p> <p>Rapid contact tracing of any positive case.</p> <p>Schools and workplaces are open and must operate safely.</p> <p>Physical distancing encouraged.</p>	<p>Bowling clubs may open but with limitations (see Best Practice - at right)</p>	<p>Bowls activity (any discipline) is permitted.</p> <p>Clubhouse capacity restricted to (recommended) 100 persons maximum</p> <p>Club events and competitions (including AGMs, prizegivings, etc.) are permitted providing the above capacity restriction is observed.</p> <p>Cleaning and hygiene protocols to be strictly observed (including hand sanitiser available throughout clubhouse for members and guests.)</p>
