


## **Weekly Reminder – 26<sup>th</sup> October 2021**

### **1. COVID UPDATE**

The Government will mandate the Covid-19 vaccine for any worker of a business that requires a vaccine certificate at entry.

Restaurants, cafes, gyms, and other “close proximity” businesses that choose to operate with greater freedoms, while requiring vaccine certification, will have to comply.

A person’s vaccination status will become increasingly relevant to how they can participate in usual activities under the Government’s proposed “traffic light” system, which will replace the alert level system when each district health board reaches 90 per cent vaccination levels.



### **TRAFFIC LIGHT SYSTEM AT A GLANCE**

A new system for Covid-19 response will take effect when all DHBs across New Zealand have 90 per cent of their population vaccinated.

### **RESURGENCE FUND**

The next payment, which is available from 29 October through myIR, will remain at the current rate of \$1,500 plus \$400 per full-time equivalent (FTE) employee, up to a maximum of 50 FTE.

Subsequent payments will be for \$3,000 plus \$800 per FTE, still up to a maximum of 50 FTE.

The frequency of the payments will also change. They will be available fortnightly, on 12 November, until Auckland moves into the new Covid Protection Framework.
