Bowls North Harbour Pennants

CONDITIONS OF PLAY:

1. **Laws and Regulations:** Played under the **Laws of the Sport of Bowls** and Bowls New Zealand Domestic Regulations as applicable.
2. **Controlling Body:** The Controlling Body for this event is the Bowls North Harbour Match Committee. The Controlling Body will have the right to alter, add to or delete any conditions of play and/or special conditions to enable the completion of the tournament.
3. **Code of Conduct:** All players will comply with and observe the requirements of the “Code of Conduct for players at Bowls North Harbour Event” as set down in the Bowls North Harbour Centre Handbook.
4. **Clothing:** All players in a team event, or singles players in a singles event, shall wear their club uniforms or other matching sports clothing which is suitable for playing the game of bowls. This means the same shirts and coloured pants (long or short is acceptable) or skirts. Logos that conflict with the event or Bowls North Harbour sponsors will not be permitted. In inclement weather jackets or other suitable outer clothing is acceptable.
5. **Postponements:** Any postponements due to weather conditions will be on the Bowls North Harbour Website & Facebook page.
6. **Mobile phone:** Use is not permitted by players on or alongside the greens during play. Cell phones must be switched off or turned to silent.
7. **Smoking Vaping Policy:** There shall be no smoking/vaping on the greens or immediate surrounds. Smoking/Vaping areas will be designated at each venue as advised by the host club duty officer. Please be advised that some clubs in North Harbour are completely smoke-free clubs.
8. **Alcohol Policy:** Alcohol shall only be consumed in areas defined by the host club liquor licence and in no event be allowed on the green or surrounds during play.
9. **Late Appearances:** When any player has failed to be in position to commence play **15 minutes** after the scheduled starting time, the game will be awarded to the opponent.
10. **Entry Fees and withdrawals:** Entry fees will be refunded to late entries and entries not accepted. No refunds will be made to teams or players who withdraw after the draw has been made. Any withdrawals must be notified to the Bowls North Harbour office by 12 noon on the day preceding the scheduled commencement of the event.
11. **Defaulters:** No team or singles player will withdraw except in the case of illness of a player or other just cause. The Controlling Body may require evidence of the illness or other just cause to be submitted.
12. **Use of greens:** Bowls North Harbour acknowledges that clubs provide their greens for use in the organisation of centre and national events. At times there

may be particular requests by clubs/greenkeepers for play to be in a certain direction and this may well be changed during the course of the event and in some cases during the day. Any such requests are approved as a condition of play for the event.

13. **Complaints:** The Bowls North Harbour Match Committee will act on any complaints and all playing disputes, provided they are provided in writing to the Bowls North Harbour Event Manager, within 10 minutes from the time recorded on the card at the finish of the game,
14. **Breach of Conditions of Play:** Where the Conditions of Play have been breached by any club, team or player then the Controlling Body for the event may take such action as to disqualify, fine or impose such other penalty against the club, team and/or player. Such action may result in the club, team or player from participating in further Centre competitions until the penalty has been discharged.
15. **Media and Communications:** Bowls New Zealand and Centres reserve the right to use any video and photographs taken during this event for further promotional requirements.
16. **Trial Ends:** Before the scheduled start of play for the first game of the day or before continuing an unfinished game on another day, one trial end may be played in each direction. A team which has a bye may practise, if it is to play an opponent which has already played a game on the green that day. Practise must not be on the rink about to play on, however the bye team may have trial ends on the rink to be played on. If it elects to do so, the opposing team may also have trial ends on that rink. Refer to Laws of the Sport of Bowls Law 5.1.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PLAY:

1. **Sides:**
 - a. Men's Premier and Mixed A sides to consist of nine (9) players playing in three (3) teams of Triples with 2 bowls for 18 ends or 2 1/2 hours whichever comes first
 - i. Men's Premier – 2 sections of 5 sides, round robin over two days
 - ii. Mixed Division A – 1 section of 4 sides, 1 round robin 29th October.
 - b. Other sides to consist of six (6) players playing in two (2) teams of Triples, playing 2 bowls for 18 ends or 2 1/2 hours whichever comes first:
 - i. Women's Premier – 1 section of 6 sides, round robin over two days
 - ii. Men's Division 1 – 2 sections round robin over two days
 - iii. Women's Division 1 – 1 section of 6 teams round robin over two days
 - iv. Mixed Division B – 1 section of 10 sides round robin playing 6 games over two days. (minimum of 2 men and 2 women in each side)
 - c. Players may change the order of play before any game, but movement between sides is not allowed.
 - d. Players in the Finals teams must have played in at least 3 section play games

2. **Play will commence by:** 9.00 am on each tournament day. Report time 8.30 am.
3. **Bowls:** Each player plays 2 bowls
4. **Defaults:** If a team defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The non-offending team will be awarded a win and the average net total of shots scored by the winning teams in the same round of the same section of the same discipline.
5. **Master Board:** A master board will be used only for divisions that have 3 team sides. e.g. the Men's Premier division and Mixed A. 2 team sides will not require a master board.
6. **Incorrect Jack Delivery:** The jack will be re-delivered by the opposite lead. If the Jack is still delivered incorrectly the jack will be placed on the 2-metre mark and the mat may be moved.
7. **Killed end:** If the end is killed the end is to be replayed.
8. **Tie in qualifying play:** In the event of a Tie in qualifying play, no extra end(s) will be played.
9. **Time limit:** All games to be completed irrespective of score within the designated time limit. If the **jack has been delivered before the time signal** the end will continue and if it subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
10. **The winning side** will be the side with the highest game and side points.
 1. 2 points are awarded for each game win (1 point for a drawn game)
 2. 4 points are awarded for each side win, giving a possible score of up to 10 points for each game.
 3. Where sides points are equal, the winner will be the side with the highest net total of shots.
 4. If net total of shots are equal the side with the lowest total shots against will be the winner.
11. **Inclement Weather:** If weather conditions affect play, a minimum of ten (10) ends will constitute a game. If a game has not reached the minimum ends, the game will be completed on a day to be advised.
12. **Restricting the movement of players during play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head after playing their second bowl apart from the skip who can visit the head after the 1st bowl.
13. **Finals:** Played on Saturday 5th November 2022 at Manly starting at 9am, with the finals commencing at 12 noon.
 - Men's Premier – top two sides in each Section will play sudden death 2 rounds.
 - Men's Division 1 – Top two sides in each section will play sudden death 2 rounds.
 - Women's Premier –Top two (2) sides will play a Final
 - Women's Division 1 –Top two (2) sides will play a Final
 - Mixed Division A –Top two (2) sides will play a Final
 - Mixed Division B – the top four (4) sides will play sudden death 2 games

14. **Tie at End of Game in the finals:** In the event of a Tie in a Finals game, **one extra end** will be played by the two teams to determine a winner.
15. **Time Limit for finals:** There is no time limit in the final game.
16. **Club Membership:** All players in a side must be full members from the same Club.
17. **Side Manager:** It is essential that each side have a manager appointed for each game. This manager may be a player in the side. The duties of a Side Manager are:
 - I. To ensure a toss is completed at the beginning of each round for all disciplines (Law 5.2). The manager will toss for all the teams in the side.
 - II. To check the score cards for each team, and that the card has been signed by the Skips as a true and correct record, before handing them to the chart person at the venue.
 - III. Ensure the names of the players are written on the card.
18. **Umpires:** As umpires are not appointed for Pennants competition, Side Managers are required to adjudicate to resolve disputes. Measuring will be done by the team, but a player in a neutral team can be called on in the event of a close measure.
19. **Prize Money:** Prize money will be paid to the clubs at the conclusion of the finals.
