## CONDITIONS OF PLAY - Cadness Cup Women

1. **General Conditions:** The "General Conditions of Play" as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent, they are applicable.
2. **Team Composition:** Two players must be 1-10 years bowling experience or graded lead or graded two in the clubs grading list. Substitute players will be permitted providing the team meets the criteria.
3. **Play will commence by:** 9:30am on Friday 3rd March, Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March and Friday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2023.
4. **Greens:** This event will be played on artificial surface greens.
5. **Bowls:** Each player will play 2 bowls in each end. Each game will consist of 12 ends.
6. **Delivery of the jack:** An incorrectly delivered Jack will not be returned but will be placed by the opposing Skip who may also direct the Lead to move the mat.
7. **Bonus Fours Scoring:** After the Twos have played their bowls, Skips (who may require a measure) to decide on the shot(s) held and a maximum of two shots to be immediately registered on the scorecard & scoreboard. Skips may find it necessary to turn a bowl over to measure for a second shot. Common sense to prevail and bowl to be replaced to the satisfaction of both skips.
8. **Umpires:** There will be no umpires. Please ask a player on the next rink to measure if required.
9. **Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead the jack is to be placed on the 2-metre spot.
10. **Restricting the Movement of Players During Play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:  
Leads: after delivery of their second bowl;  
Twos: after delivery of their second bowl;  
Threes: after delivery of their second bowl;  
Skips: after delivery of their first bowl.
11. **Time Limit:** A time limit of 1 ¼ hours will apply in all matches. If the jack has been delivered before the end of the signalled time, the end will continue and if the end subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
12. **Defaults:** If a team defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The non-offending team will be awarded a win and the average net total of shots scored by the winning teams in the same round of the same section.
13. **Round Robin Play:** Entries will be drawn into one section with each team playing all other teams. This will result in being three games on each of the first two days of play and one round on the final day of play.
14. **Determining the Event Winner:** Three points will be awarded for each game won. One point will be awarded to each team if a game is tied. Where game points are equal the winner of the event will be the team with the highest net total of shots. If the game points and the net total of shots are equal the team with the lowest "total shots against" will be the winner. If these are equal, the team that won the game when the two teams met will be the winner. If still equal an extra end must be played between the two teams.

15. **Inclement Weather:** During qualifying play, if weather conditions affect play a minimum of eight [8] ends will constitute a game. If weather forces abandonment of play, three completed games will constitute completion of section play, and a result found from the three completed games. Each venue will be considered a separate competition when applying this condition.

16. **Prize Money:** Prize money will be paid at the completion of the tournament to the winning clubs.
