Conditions of Play for Champ of Champ Triples

1. **General Conditions:** The “General Conditions of Play” as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent, they are applicable.
2. **Play will commence by:** 9:00 am on Saturday 13th May 2023 for the first round of play. Players who are not scheduled to play in the first round must report by 10.00am on Saturday 13th May. On Sunday 14th May, play will commence by 9.00am for both women and men at Browns Bay.
3. **Greens:** This event will be played on artificial surface greens.
4. **Bowls:** Each player will play 2 bowls in each end.
5. **Ends:** Up to eighteen (18) ends will be played in each game subject to the time limit.
6. **Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead it must be replayed.
7. **Time Limit:** A time limit of 2 hours and 15 minutes will apply in all games except the final which will have no time limit. If the jack has been delivered before the end of the signalled time, the end will continue and if the end subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
8. **Restricting the Movement of Players During Play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:
 - Leads: after delivery of their second bowl;
 - Twos: after delivery of their second bowl;
 - Skip: after delivery of their first and second bowl.
9. **Defaults:** If a team defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The non-offending team will be awarded a win.
10. **Order of Play:** The order of play will be randomly drawn. All games will be played to find a winner of each game played. If after the required ends are completed, or the time limit is signalled, and the scores are equal, an extra end or ends will be played to decide the winner.
11. **Inclement Weather:** In the case of inclement weather ten (10) ends will constitute a game. This will only apply to games which have not been commenced. Any games already commenced are required to be completed to eighteen (18) ends. If the weather forces abandonment of play before the event is completed the balance of games will be transferred to the next available reserve day.
12. **Trophy and Prize Money:** The presentation of the trophy will be made immediately following the conclusion of the final and prize money will be paid to the club.
13. **Event Entitlement:** The winning team for each competition (men and women) will be entitled to enter the national Champion of Champion event being held in Dunedin from 14 July to 16 July, 2023.


