SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PLAY:

- 1. General Conditions:** The "General Conditions of Play" as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent they are applicable.
- 2. Play Commencement Time:** Play will commence by: 9:00 am on Saturday 10th June and 8:30 am on Sunday 11th June.
- 3. Qualifying:** Entries will be drawn into sections of 4, a round robin of 3 games of 12 ends or 1¾ hours.
- 4. Bowls:** Each player will play in the 2-4-2 format.
- 5. Clothing:** For this tournament matching clothing is not required
- 6. Defaults:** If a team defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The non-offending team will be awarded a win and the average net total of shots scored by the winning teams in the same round of the same section.
- 7. Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead it must be replayed in the same player sequence.
- 8. Time limit:** All games to be continued irrespective of the score until the designated time limit (1¾ hours) is over or until the game is finished, whichever comes first. If the jack has been delivered before the time signal, the end will continue and if it subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
- 9. Restricting the Movement of Players During Play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:
The player who is playing the final two bowls of the end is allowed to visit the head before delivering the final bowl.
- 10. Determining a winner:** In all section play games, three points will be awarded for each game won and one point will be awarded for each game drawn. Where game points are equal the winner of each section will be the team with the highest net total of shots. If the game points and the net total of shots are equal the team with the lowest "total shots against" will be the winner. If these are equal, the team that won the game when the two teams met will be the section winner. If the two leading teams have drawn their game and have equal – game points, highest net total of shots for and lowest total shots against – then the 2 teams will play an extra end to decide the winner of the section.
- 11. Post Section:** The winners of all sections, plus the one next best team over all the sections, will qualify for post section play on day 2. The next best team will be determined by the same process as in "Determining a winner" and if there is an equal situation after applying those parameters then a toss shall be decided to determine the lucky loser. The winning teams of the first round of the post section play will play the quarter finals in the MAIN competition and the losing teams in the first round of post section play will play in a FLIGHT competition, both over three knockout rounds.
- 12. Prize Money:** Prize money will be paid at the conclusion of the event. The winning team of the MAIN competition will receive \$400, the runner-up team \$200 and the two losing semi-finalist teams \$100 each. For the FLIGHT competition the winning team will receive \$200, the runner-up team \$100 and the two losing semi-finalist teams \$50 each.
- 13. Inclement weather:** During qualifying play, if weather conditions affect play, a minimum of eight (8) ends will constitute a game. If weather forces abandonment of play, two (2) completed games will constitute the completion of the section play, and a result will be found from the two (2) completed games. Each venue will be considered a separate competition when applying this rule. If weather forces abandonment at any one venue before the completion of at least two (2) qualifying games, the event will be cancelled and the entry fees will be refunded. If weather condition force abandonment of post section play, prize money will be divided among the teams remaining in the event at the time of abandonment.



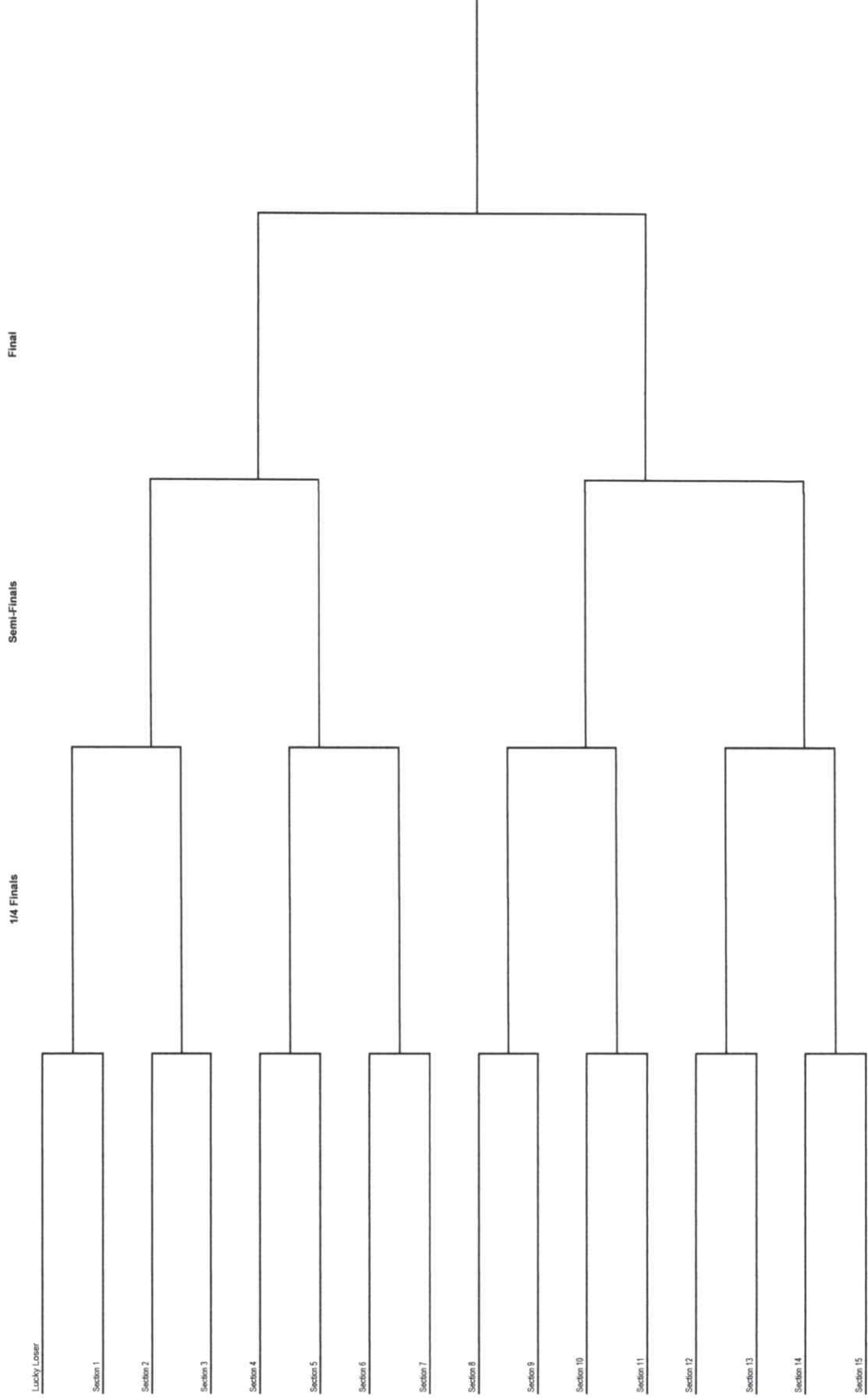
