Conditions of Play for Women Winter Cup

- 1. General Conditions:** The "General Conditions of Play" as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent, they are applicable.
- 2. Greens:** This event will be played on artificial surface greens.
- 3. Clothing:** For this tournament mufti clothing is acceptable.
- 4. Play will commence by:** 9:30 am on each playing day.
- 5. Bowls:** Each player will play 2 bowls in each end.
- 6. Trial Ends:** No trial ends for the Winter Cup competition will be allowed.
- 7. Umpires:** There will be no umpires appointed to this competition. Ask a person from a neighbouring rink if this is required.
- 8. Ends:** Up to twelve (12) ends will be played in each game subject to the time limit.
- 9. Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead the jack is placed on the 2 metre mark.
- 10. Incorrect Delivery of the Jack:** An incorrectly delivered jack will be placed by the opposing skip.
- 11. Time Limit:** A time limit of 1 ¾ hours will apply in all games. If the jack has been delivered before the end of the signalled time, the end will continue and if the end subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
- 12. Restricting the Movement of Players During Play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:
 - Leads: after delivery of their second bowl;
 - Twos: after delivery of their second bowl;
 - Threes: after delivery of their second bowl;
 - Skip: after delivery of their first bowl.
- 13. Defaults:** If a team defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The non-offending team will be awarded a win and the average of the net total of shots from all other games in that round and in that section.
- 14. Scoring:** After the twos have played their bowls, skips (who may require a measure) will decide on the shot(s) held and a maximum of two shots are to be immediately registered on the scoreboard to the leading team.
- 15. Tie at end of Game:** In the event of a tie in qualifying play, no extra end will be played to determine a winner.
- 16. Qualifying:** Entries will be blind drawn into three sections of six teams with a round robin of five games played. The first three games will be played on the first day and then the last two games of round robin played on the second day. Following the second game on day two a one game knockout round will be played.
- 17. Byes in qualifying play:** Should there not be an even number of teams then a section(s) may contain a bye. The bye will be treated as a win and the average of the net total of shots from all other games in that round and in that section will be awarded to the bye team.
- 18. Determining a section winner:** In all games three points will be awarded for each game won and one point for a drawn game. Where game points are equal the winner will be the team with the highest net total of shots. If the game points and the net total of shots are equal, the team with the lowest "total shots against" will be the winner. If these are equal the winner will be determined by the toss of a coin.

- 19. Post Section:** The winning and runner-up teams in each section plus the next two best teams overall sections will qualify for the one game knockout round on day two. The next two best teams will be determined by the same process as in "Determining a section winner" above. The four winning teams from the knockout round will play a round robin of three games on day three to determine the winner of the competition. Determining the winner of this round robin will use the same points basis as detailed in "Determining a section winner" above.
- 20. Inclement Weather:** In the case of inclement weather eight (8) ends will constitute a game. If weather conditions force an abandonment of play, three completed games will constitute completion of section play, and a result found from the three completed games. In the event of the round robin qualifying not being completed the Event Director has discretion to determine the post section format which maybe as set out in COP 18 or an alternative format on day 3.
- 21. Prize Money:** Prize money will be paid to the clubs at the conclusion of the event.
