PENNANTS 2023 – MIXED EVENT

- 1. **General Conditions:** The "General Conditions of Play" as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent, they are applicable.
- 2. Greens: This event will be played on artificial surface greens.
- 3. **Sides:** Each team side will consist of six players from the same club playing in two teams of triples. Each side must have a minimum of 2 men and 2 women in each side with one of each gender playing in each of the triples teams. Players may change their order of play before any game and move between teams within the same club side. Players may not change from one club side to another club side. Players in the sides for the finals must have played in at least three qualifying games for the side.
- 4. Play will commence by: 9.00am on each playing date. Trial ends must be completed before that time.
- 5. Bowls: Each player will play 2 bowls in each end with games being of 18 ends.
- 6. Time limit: A time limit of 2 ¼ hours will be applied in all games. There will be no time limit for the final match. If the jack has been delivered before the end of the signalled time, the end will continue and if the end subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
- 7. **Incorrect Delivery of Jack:** In the event of incorrect delivery of the jack it will be re-delivered by the opposing lead. If the jack is still delivered incorrectly, the jack will be placed on the 2-metre mark and the mat may be moved by the first lead.
- 8. **Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead it must be replayed.
- 9. **Restricting the Movement of Players During Play:** in all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:
 - a. Leads: after delivery of their second bowl.
 - b. Twos: after delivery of their second bowl.
 - c. Skips: after delivery of their first bowl.
- 10. **Qualifying**: Entries will be randomly drawn into one section of ten sides, playing a maximum six matches in round robin format. Three rounds of qualifying will be played on each of the first and second days. All games in qualifying must be completed in full if the result has any bearing on the potential qualification of any team within the section.
- 11. Byes in Qualifying Play: Should there not be an even number of teams then a section may contain a bye. The bye will be treated as a win and the average of shots for and shots against of the remaining games in that round will be awarded to the bye team.
- 12. **Defaults:** If a team defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The non-offending team will be awarded a win and the average of shots for and shots against of the remaining games in that round.
- 13. **Scoring:** A master board will be used for all matches. A match is between two teams from one side playing two teams from an opposing side. Eight game points are available for each match.
 - a. Four game points will be awarded to the side with the best total differential over both games. In the event of the differential being equal then each side will be awarded two game points each.
 - b. Two game points will be awarded to each team win. In the event of a tie then each team will be awarded one game point each.

- 14. Qualifiers for Post Section: In the event that two or more sides have an equal number of game points then the side with the highest number of shots differential shall be the winner. In the event the sides are still equal then the side with the highest number of shots for shall be the winner, and if still equal the side with the lowest number of shots against shall be the winner.
- 15. **Post Section:** The top four sides will qualify for the semi-finals with the winning side playing the fourth placed side; and the second placed side playing the third placed side. The winning sides of the two semi-final matches will play the final.
- 16. Inclement Weather: During qualifying play, if weather conditions affect play a minimum of ten [10] ends will constitute a game. If weather conditions force abandonment of play, two completed matches will constitute completion of section play, and a result found from the two completed matches. Each venue will be considered a separate competition when applying this condition. If weather conditions forces abandonment at any one venue before the completion of at least two matches of qualifying, the balance of events will be transferred to Day Two. If Day Two play is affected by weather conditions, the balance of the matches will be transferred to the next available reserve day.
- **17. Side Manager:** Each side must be represented by a manager appointed for each side. This manager may be a player in the side. The duties of the side manager are:
 - a. To ensure the names of the players are written on the team sheet and handed to the Event Director, or their nominee, prior to the commencement of the first match of the day;
 - b. To ensure a toss is completed at the beginning of each round, with the winner of the toss choosing to take the mat or give this to the opposing team for both games;
 - c. To check the score cards for each game and that the card has been signed by the skips of both teams before handing the cards to the Event Director or their nominee at the venue.
- **18. Umpires:** As umpires are not appointed for the Pennants competition, side managers are required to adjudicate to resolve disputes. Measuring will be done by the team, but a player in a neutral team can be called on in the event of a close measure.


