CONDITIONS OF PLAY - Cadness Cup (Women)

1. **General Conditions:** The "General Conditions of Play" as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent they are applicable.
2. **Team Composition:** All players in each club side must be members of the same club. Substitute players will be permitted providing the team meets the criteria. There are to be separate competitions for each gender.
3. **Play will commence by:** 9:30 am on Friday 1st March, Friday 8th March and Friday 22nd March 2024.
4. **Greens:** This event may be played on artificial surface greens or natural grass greens.
5. **Bowls:** Each player will play 2 bowls in each with each game consisting of 12 ends.
6. **Delivery of the jack:** An incorrectly delivered Jack will not be returned, but will be placed by the opposing Skip who may also direct the Lead to move the mat.
7. **Bonus Fours Scoring:** After the Twos have played their bowls, Skips (who may require a measure) to decide on the number of shots held (with a maximum of two shots) to be immediately registered on the scoreboard. Skips may find it necessary to turn a bowl over to measure for a second shot. Common sense to prevail and bowl to be replaced to the satisfaction of both skips.
8. **Umpires:** There will be no umpires. Please ask a player on the next rink to measure if required.
9. **Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead the jack is to be placed on the 2-metre spot.
10. **Restricting the Movement of Players During Play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:
 - a. Leads: after delivery of their second bowl;
 - b. Twos: after delivery of their second bowl;
 - c. Threes: after delivery of their second bowl;
 - d. Skips: after delivery of their first bowl.
11. **Time Limit:** A time limit of 1 ¼ hours will apply in all matches. If the jack has been delivered before the end of the signalled time, the end will continue and if the end subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
12. **Qualifying:** Entries will be drawn into two sections of 6 teams in each section. A round robin of 5 games will be played in each section. The first day will have three rounds and the second day will have two rounds. The first two teams in each section will then qualify for the final day which will be another round robin of four teams. Teams will be blind drawn into this final round robin. All games in qualifying must be completed in full if the result has any bearing on the potential qualification of any team within the section.
13. **Ties in Qualifying Play:** if a game is tied at the completion of a game, or after the end is completed when the time limit is signalled, or at the completion of the minimum number of ends as stated in the condition of play "Inclement weather" below, then both teams will be awarded one point.
14. **Byes in Qualifying Play:** Should there not be an even number of teams then a section(s) may contain a bye. A team that has a bye will be awarded three (3) points and the average net total of shots scored by the winning teams in the same round of the same section.

15. **Defaults:** If a team defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The non-offending team will be awarded a win and the average net total of shots scored by the winning teams in the same round of the same section.
16. **Determining a Section Winner:** Three points will be awarded for each game won. One point will be awarded to each team if a game is tied. Where game points are equal the winner of each section will be the team with the highest net total of shots. If the game points and the net total of shots are equal the team with the lowest "total shots against" will be the winner. If these are equal, the team that won the game when the two teams met will be the section winner. If still equal an extra end must be played between the two teams.
17. **Post Section:** The post-section play will be played on the final day of the competition. It will consist of a round robin of play with the four teams qualifying from section play. Games in the post section round will use the same scoring system as in section play. The winner of this round robin will be the winner of the competition.
18. **Inclement Weather:** During qualifying play, if weather conditions affect play a minimum of eight [8] ends will constitute a game. If weather forces abandonment of play, three completed games will constitute completion of section play, and a result found from the three completed games. Each venue will be considered a separate competition when applying this condition.
19. **Extenuating Circumstances:** In the event of extenuating circumstances preventing the normal continuation of play from the weather or any other cause these Conditions of Play for this event may be varied by the Bowls North Harbour Match Committee.
20. **Prize Money:** Prize money will be paid at the completion of the tournament to the winning clubs.
