1-5 year Interclub

1. **General Conditions:** The "General Conditions of Play" as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent they are applicable.
2. **Format of Side:** Each side will comprise of 6 players, any combination. A Singles player, a Pairs team and a Triples team. A 7th person must be named as a reserve and can play in any position. This player also acts as a marker for singles games. All players must be graded 1-5 years of bowling experience.
3. **Club Membership:** All players in a side must be from the same Club. In exceptional circumstances the Centre may allow a composite side to enter if a club or clubs have insufficient members to form a side. The players in a composite team may wear their own club colours.
4. **Order of Play:** Players may not interchange between the singles, pairs and triples disciplines during a game but the teams within the side may be changed before a game, including the named reserve, if required. A player cannot be changed between sides if a club has more than one club side in the competition.
5. **Play will commence by:** 8:30am on Saturday 20th April and 8.30am on Sunday 21st April.
6. **Bowls:** Each player will play 4 bowls in each end in Singles play, 3 bowls in each end in Pairs play and 2 bowls in each end in Triples play.
7. **Format of play:** Singles play will be to 21 shots, Pairs teams playing 15 ends, and Triples teams playing 15 ends.
8. **Time Limit:** A time limit of 2 hours will be applied for all games in qualifying and post section play. If the jack has been delivered before the end of the signalled time, the end will continue and if the end subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
9. **Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead it must be replayed.
10. **Restricting the movement of players during play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:
 - Singles:** After the delivery of their third and fourth bowl.
 - Pairs:**
 - Leads:** After the delivery of their third bowl.
 - Skips:** After the delivery of their second bowl.
 - Triples:**
 - Leads:** After delivery of their second bowl.
 - Seconds:** After delivery of their second bowl.
 - Skips:** After delivery of each of their bowls.

11 Qualifying Play: Sides will be drawn into sections of four (4) and six (6) sides. The sides in sections of 4 sides will play each other. In the section of 6 sides there will be a draw with each side playing three other sides in the same section. The qualifiers for post section play on day 2 will be:

- (a) The winners of the sections containing 4 sides in each section;
- (b) The top two sides in the section containing 6 sides;
- (c) The three next best sides over all sections.

The three next best sides over all sections will be determined on the same scoring basis as in "Determining a Section Winner".

12. Ties in qualifying play: If a game is tied at the completion of the number of ends, or after the end is completed when the time limit is signalled, or at the completion of the minimum number of ends as stated in the conditions of play "Inclement Weather" below, then both teams will be awarded one point.

13. Byes in Qualifying Play: Should there not be an even number of sides then a section(s) may contain a bye. The bye will be treated as a win and no shot differential applied.

14. Defaults: If a team or singles player defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The nonoffending team or singles player will be awarded a win and the average net total of shots scored by the winning teams or singles players in the same round of the same section of the same discipline.

15 Determining a Section Winner: The finishing position of each side shall be determined as follows:

- (a) Highest match points (a match meaning the three games of each discipline played between the two sides) where two points will be awarded for each match won and one point for each match drawn;
- (b) Where match points are equal the side with the highest game points (with one game point being awarded for each game won within a match and half a game point awarded for each game tied) shall be the superior side;
- (c) If match points and game points are tied at the end of the qualifying rounds, the side which has the highest total of net shots (shots gained less shots conceded equals total net shots) shall be the superior side;
- (d) If at the end of the qualifying rounds, match points, game points and total net shots are unable to separate two or more sides, the side with the highest total of shots gained across all games in all matches shall be the superior side.

16. Post Section Play: There will be eight sides qualifying for post section play. The four winning sides from each section will play the other four qualifying sides: see Post Section draw below. Post section play will be to find a winning side from each match played, with the scoring on the same basis as in "Determining a Section Winner".

- 17. Inclement Weather:** During qualifying play, if weather conditions affect play a minimum of eleven [11] ends in singles, a minimum eight (8) ends in pairs, and a minimum [8] ends in triples will constitute a match. If weather forces abandonment of play, two completed matches will constitute completion of section play, and a result found from the two completed games. If Day Two play is affected by weather conditions, the balance of the matches will be transferred to the next available reserve day.
- 18. Advice:** It is permissible for any Accredited Coach or Manager to advise a Player(s) in their side during the course of this competition as permitted in accordance with Law 44 of the Laws of the Sport.
- 19. Side Manager:** It is essential that each side have a manager appointed for each game. This manager may be a player in the side. The duties of a Side Manager are:
- (a) To list the correct names of the members of their side on the team sheet prior to the start of play for each tournament day.
 - (b) To ensure a toss is completed at the beginning of each round for all games in a match (Law 5.2).
 - (c) To ensure that score cards for each game are completed in full for each round.
- 20. Markers:** Each team **must** provide a marker, which can be the 7th player.
- 21. Winning Side:** The club side winning this event will be eligible to take up the Bowls North Harbour allocation for entry into the Mercedes Cup event to be played in Northland and expected to be in May 2024.

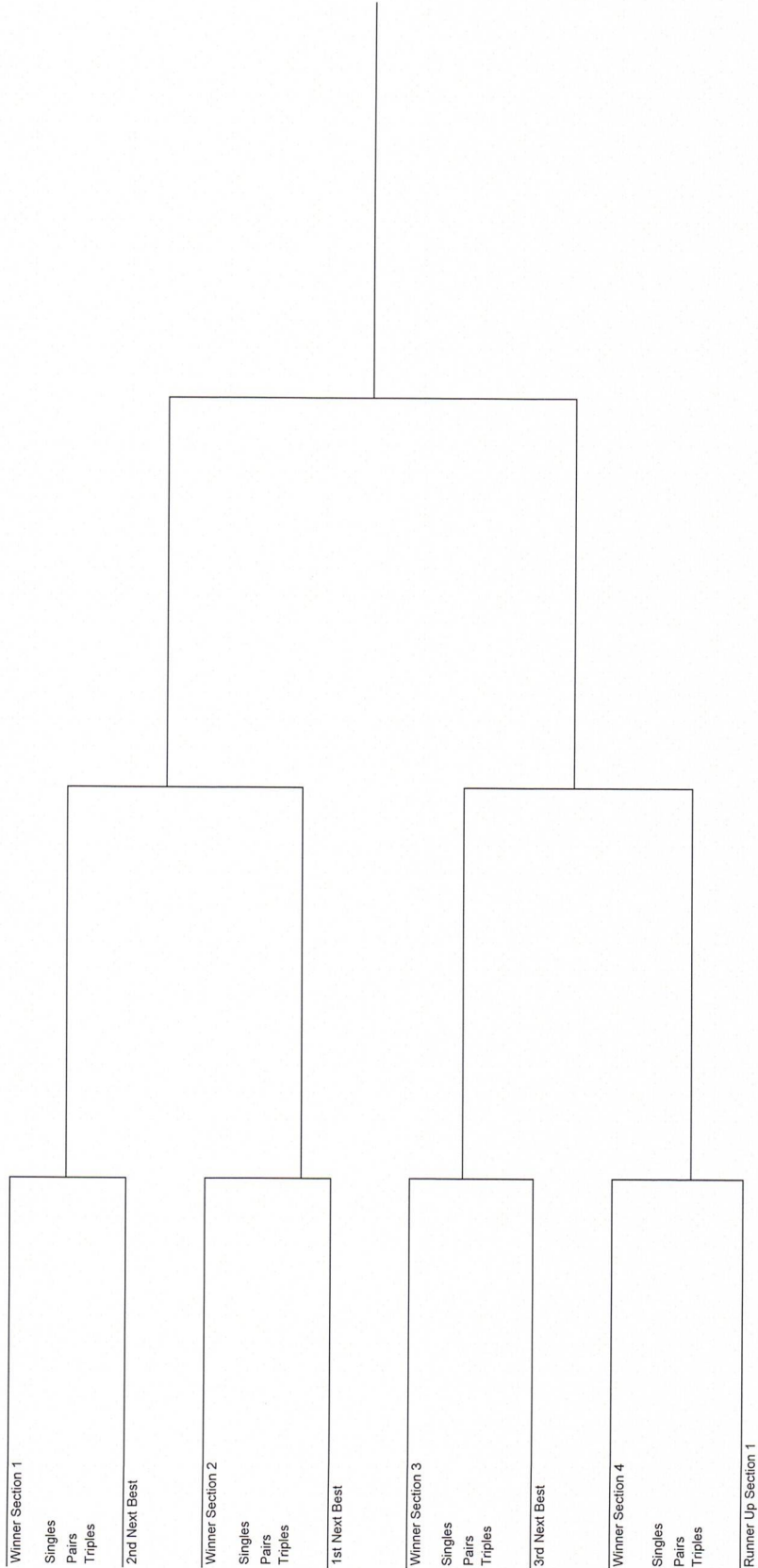

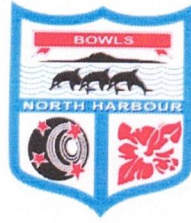
