Conditions of Play for BNH Champ of Champ Pairs

- 1. **General Conditions:** The "General Conditions of Play" as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent, they are applicable.
- 2. **Play will commence by**: 9:00 am on Saturday 11th May 2024 for the first round of play. Players who are not scheduled to play in the first round must report by 10.00 am on Saturday 11th May. For the Men, it is planned to play the first three rounds Round 1, the Round of 16 and the Quarter-finals on day 1, and then the Semi-finals and Final will be held on day 2 commencing at 10.00am. For the Women it is planned to play Round 1 and the Quarter-finals on day 1 starting at 9:00 am and the Semi-finals and Final on day 2, starting at 10:00 am.
- 3. Greens: This event will be played on artificial surface greens.
- 4. **Bowls:** Each player will play 3 bowls in each end.
- 5. Ends: Up to eighteen (18) ends will be played in each game subject to the time limit.
- 6. **Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead it must be replayed.
- 7. **Time Limit:** A time limit of 2 hours and 15 minutes will apply in all games except the final which will have no time limit. If the jack has been delivered before the end of the signalled time, the end will continue and if the end subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
- 8. **Restricting the Movement of Players During Play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:

Leads after they have played their third bowl;

Skips after they have played their second and third bowl.

- 9. **Order of Play:** The order of play will be randomly drawn. All games will be played to find a winner of each game played. If after the required ends are completed, or the time limit is signalled, and the scores are equal, an extra end or ends will be played to decide the winner.
- 10. **Inclement Weather:** If weather forces abandonment of play before the completion of the event on day 2 then the balance of the games will be scheduled for Sunday 19th May, 2024.
- **11. Trophy Presentation:** The presentation of trophy will be made immediately following the conclusion of the final.
- **12. Event Entitlement:** The winning team for each competition (men and women) will be entitled to enter the national Champion of Champion event being held in Dunedin from 26th to 28th June 2024.
