**Conditions of Play for the
Bowls North Harbour PENNANTS 2025**

1. General Conditions: The "General Conditions of Play" as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent they are applicable.
2. Greens: This event may be played on grass greens or artificial surface greens depending on availability.
3. Sides: Each side will consist of nine players from the same club, in any combination, playing in three teams of triples. Players may change their order of play before any game and move between teams within the same club side. Players may not change from one club side to another club side. Players in the sides for the finals must have played in at least three qualifying games for the side.
4. Incorrect Delivery of Jack: In the event of incorrect delivery of the jack it will be re-delivered by the opposing lead. If the jack is still delivered incorrectly, the jack will be placed on the 2-metre mark and the mat may be moved by the first lead.
5. Dead Ends: If an end becomes dead it must be replayed.
6. Restricting the Movement of Players During Play: In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances – Leads and twos after delivery of their second bowl; Skips after delivery of their first bowl.
7. Qualifying: Team sides will play a round robin twice with the clubs allocated to each zone. For the qualifying rounds the venue allocation will be closely aligned to a home and away situation to the extent possible.
8. Defaults: If a side or a team defaults all games then the default will be treated the same as a bye. i.e. the non-defaulting side or team will be recorded as a win and no shots differential applied. If a side or team defaults in less than all the rounds, they will score no points for the rounds defaulted. Their opponents in these rounds will receive the points for a win and the average points for and against of the remaining games in that round and in that zone.
9. Byes in qualifying Play: Should there not be an even number of sides in a zone then that zone may contain a bye. The bye will be treated as a win for that side with maximum game points and no shot differential applied. If due to inclement weather, or any other factor, and not all sides receive the benefit of the bye, then the Event Director, in consultation with the Match Committee, has the discretion to determine the game points and shots for and against for the sides so affected.
10. Scoring: A master board will be used for all matches. A match is between three teams from one side playing three teams from an opposing side. Ten game points are available for each match.
 - a. Four game points will be awarded to the side with the highest total differential over all three games. In the event of the differential over all three games being equal then each side will be awarded two game points each.
 - b. Two game points will be awarded to each team win. In the event of a tie in a game or games then each team will be awarded one game point each.
11. Determining the Winning Side: In each zone after all qualifying games have been completed the side with the highest number of game points will be the winner. Where the game points are equal the winning side will be the side with the highest net total of shots scored. If the game points and the net total of shots scored are equal, the side with the lowest total shots against will be the winner. If these are equal the winning side will be determined by the toss of a coin.
12. Finals Play: The winning side of each zone will qualify for the finals play-off. Finals play will be to find a winning side of each game played. If game points between two sides are tied at the end of the match, then the winning side will be determined on the same basis as in condition 11.

13. Inclement Weather: If weather conditions affect play a minimum of ten [10] ends will constitute a game in any match. If weather conditions force abandonment of play before any match can be completed then the match will be declared a draw and both sides will be allocated five game points each. Four completed games will constitute completion of zone play, and a result found from the four completed games. Each venue will be considered a separate competition when applying this condition. In the event of the round robin qualifying zone play not being completed the Event Director, in consultation with the Match Committee, has the discretion to determine the teams for finals play.
14. Side Manager: Each side must be represented by a manager appointed to each side. This manager may be a player in the side. The duties of the side manager are:
- a. To ensure the names of the players are written on the team sheet and handed to the Event Director, or their nominee, prior to the commencement of the first match of the day;
 - b. To ensure a toss is completed at the beginning of each match, with the winner of the toss choosing to take the mat or give this to the opposing side for all three games in the match;
 - c. To check the score cards for each of the three games in the match, that the card has been signed by the skips of both teams for each game before handing the cards to the Event Director or their nominee at the venue.
15. Umpires: There will be no umpires appointed for the Pennants competition. Side managers are required to adjudicate to resolve disputes and measuring may be done by a player in a neutral team if required.
16. Prize money: Prize money will be paid to the clubs at the conclusion of the event.
