SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PLAY for the Bowls North Harbour WOMEN CENTRE SINGLES

1. **General Conditions:** The "General Conditions of Play" as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent they are applicable.
2. **Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead it must be replayed.
3. **Restricting the Movement of Players During Play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head after delivery of their third bowl.
4. **Incorrect Delivery of the Jack:** An incorrectly delivered jack will be placed by the opposing player.
5. **Delivered Jack:** If the jack has been delivered before the end of the signalled time, the end will continue and if the end subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
6. **Qualifying:** All games in qualifying must be completed in full if the result has any bearing on the potential qualification of any player within the section.
7. **Ties in Qualifying Play:** If a game is tied after the end is completed when the time limit is signalled, or at the completion of the minimum number of ends as stated in the conditions of play "**Inclement Weather**" below, then both players will be awarded one point.
8. **Byes in Qualifying Play:** Should there not be an even number of players then a section(s) may contain a bye. The bye will be treated as a win and no shot differential applied.
9. **Marking:** All players are required to mark one round of Section play. This is indicated on the chart by an "M". Any player who fails to mark their scheduled game when required will be immediately disqualified from the competition. The host club is kindly asked to provide additional markers where these are required.
10. **Defaults:** If a player defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. If all rounds of section play are completed the winner of the section will be determined from the result of the three games played between the three players remaining in the section. If due to weather or other circumstances, three rounds of section play are not able to be completed, then the player that won by default will be awarded a win and the average net total of shots scored by the winning player in the same round in the same section.
11. **Determining a Section Winner:** Three points will be awarded for each game won. One point will be awarded to each player if a game is tied. Where game points are equal the winner of each section will be the player with the highest total of shots scored. If the game points and shots scored are equal the player with the highest net total of shots will be the winner. If these are equal, the player that won the game when the two players met will be the section winner.
12. **Post Section:** The winner from each section will qualify to Post Section play. Post Section play will be to find a winner of each game played. If the scores are tied when the time limit is signalled, then one further tie-break end will be played to determine a winner.
13. **Inclement Weather:** During qualifying play, if weather conditions affect play a minimum of eleven [11] ends will constitute a game. If weather forces abandonment of play, 2 completed games will constitute completion of section play, and a result found from the 2 completed games. If Day Two play is affected by weather conditions, the balance of games will be transferred to the next available reserve day.
14. **Trophy and Prize Money:** The presentation of trophy and prize money will be made immediately following the conclusion of the final.
