Conditions of Play for the BNH Champion of Champion Singles

1. **General Conditions:** The "General Conditions of Play" as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent they are applicable.
2. **Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead it must be replayed.
3. **Restricting the Movement of Players During Play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head after delivery of their third and fourth bowl.
4. **Time Limit:** A time limit of 2 ¼ hours will apply in all games except the final which will have no time limit. If the jack has been delivered before the end of the signalled time, the end will continue and if the end subsequently becomes dead, it will be replayed.
5. **Defaults:** If a player defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The non-offending player will be awarded a win.
6. **Marking:** Players must be accompanied by a marker. All losing players may be required to mark a following game. Players must not leave the venue before checking with the Event Director as to the requirement to mark a subsequent game.
7. **Order of Play:** The order of play will be randomly drawn. All games will be played to find a winner of each game played, being the first to 21 shots or the clear winner after the end is completed when the time limit is signalled. If the scores are tied at the end when the time limit is signalled, then one further end will be played to determine the winner.
8. **Inclement Weather:** If weather forces abandonment of play before the completion of the event the balance of games will be transferred to the next available reserve day.
9. **Event Entitlement:** The winning player for each competition (Men and Women) will be entitled to enter the National Champion of Champion event.
