## **SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PLAY for the Champion of Champion Four.**

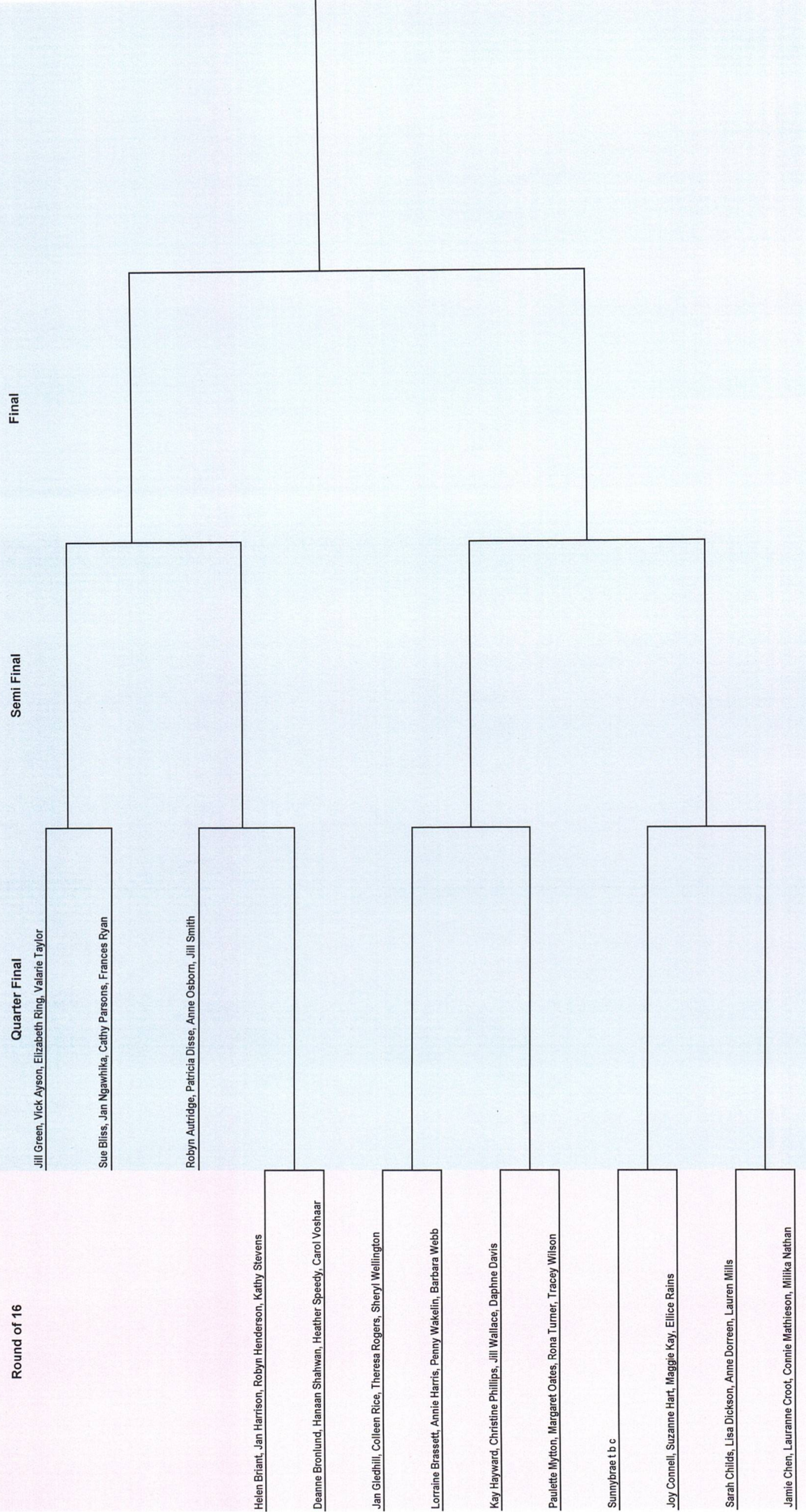
1. **General Conditions:** The “General Conditions of Play” as they are available on the Bowls North Harbour website will apply to this event to the extent they are applicable.
2. **Dead Ends:** If an end becomes dead it must be replayed.
3. **Restricting the Movement of Players During Play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:
  - The players playing as lead, second and third: after delivery of their second bowl.
  - The player playing as Skip, after delivery of their first bowl.
4. **Defaults:** If a team defaults their score will be recorded as a loss. The non-offending team will be awarded a win.
5. **Order of Play:** The order of play will be randomly drawn. All games will be played to find a winner of each game played. If after the required ends are completed the scores are equal, an extra end or ends will be played to decide the winner.
6. **Inclement Weather:** In the case of inclement weather ten (10) ends will constitute a game. This will only apply to games which have not been commenced. Any games already commenced are required to be completed to fifteen (15) ends. If the weather forces abandonment of play before the event is completed the balance of games will be transferred to the next available reserve day.
7. **Event Entitlement:** The winning team for each competition will be entitled to enter the BNZ National Champion of Champion events, the Men at Dunedin on 24<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> July 2026 and the Women in Hastings on 31<sup>st</sup> July to 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2026.
